Information

Parent/Actor Agreement

1. Rehearsals / Performances:

Rehearsal dates for this production are **9/17/22 – 10/19/22**. Rehearsals will take place at the **530 Studios, 530 Fifth Ave, Pelham, NY**. Performances will take place at the **530 Studios** from **10/20 – 10/23**. There will be one cast, ***potentially two tracks and six (6) performances – 10/20 @ 7pm, 10/21 @ 7pm, 10/22 @ 2pm and 7pm, and 10/23 @ 2pm and 7pm**. (**If there are two tracks, then each person sharing a role will play that role 3 times and fill in as Ensemble for the other 3.*) Rehearsals will be held from **6:00pm – 9:00pm on weekdays, 2:00pm – 6:00pm on Saturdays and 12:00pm – 4:00pm on Sundays (*hours changing / increasing during tech week)**. While it will not be “everyday” or “every hour” in that timeframe (schedule to follow after casting), it will be a minimum of **3 weekdays and some part if not all of both weekend days**. All cast members will need to be fully vaccinated by the start of rehearsal – there will be no masks worn during rehearsals and performances. PLEASE CHECK OUR SAFETY PROTOCOLS at www.sooptheatre.org for a better understanding of what to expect.

2. Fees / Ads: Total / \$650

If cast, there is a fee of **\$650** which must be paid in order to participate. This includes a **\$575 tuition fee, \$50 ad sale deposit and a \$25 video link pre-order fee** so you will have a copy of the show to keep. Once the cast list is posted, parents will be notified via email and directed to our website to finalize the payment/registration process. **Scholarships are available** - if you are interested, please go to www.sooptheatre.org and click on “forms” under ‘kid’s programs’ for the application. **All cast members must be paid up by the date required (Saturday, Sept 17, 2022) in order to attend the first rehearsal in the Fall – no exceptions! We want to make sure that we have a full company, ready to hit the ground running on 9/17 and we do not want to be tracking people for payment!**

3. Parent Volunteers:

Part of the commitment you make as parents when signing up your child for this show is to volunteer in some capacity to assist with the production. This could mean anything from box office, concessions, costume assistance, usher, cast party and ad sales. Most jobs only involve one performance or one afternoon's commitment. We will have a sign-up list with the various jobs outlined and will reach out to you via email for a commitment. **ALL families must volunteer for at least one job during this process.** NOTE: if you are interested in taking on the role of AD SALE COORDINATOR, **your child will participate tuition-free!** We offer this because we recognize that it is an important responsibility and we want to make sure that we have the right person at the helm.
